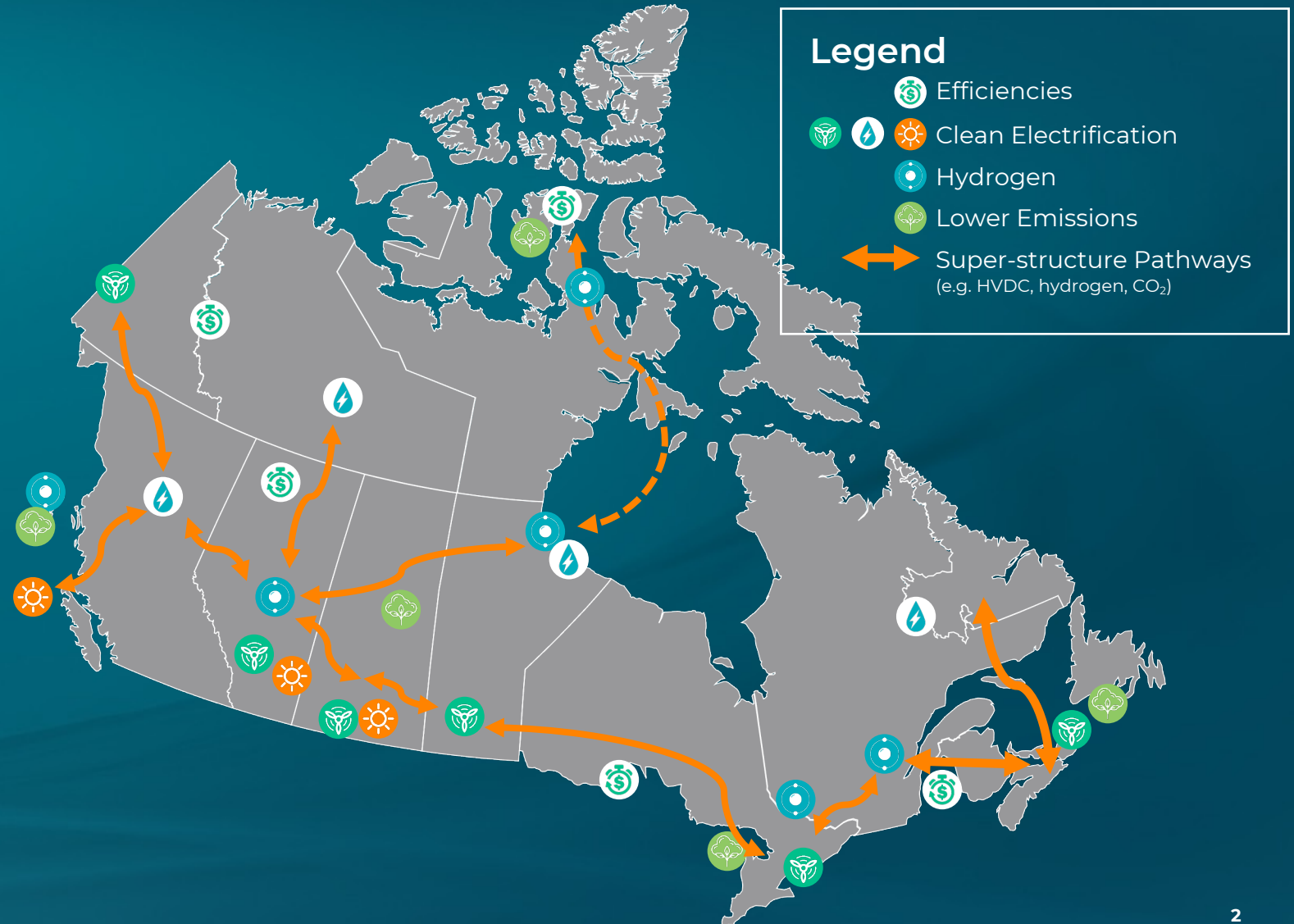

CANADA'S LOW CARBON CORRIDOR

NATIONAL DECARBONIZATION SUPER-STRUCTURE PATHWAYS

The CVP interconnects commercially critical markets with clean resources from across Canada, creating and bolstering opportunities for decarbonization and economic prosperity in all regions of Canada.



Locating routes for corridors and new infrastructure should seek to optimize and build efficiency while reducing both social and environmental impacts

PRINCIPLES OF CVP CORRIDOR LOCATION

- Functional not Notional - Must solve or optimize identifiable and tangible problems that are either "latent" (current value) or tangible and quantifiable future needs,
- Upfront Support - Establish clear local, Indigenous, regional and national support for specific route selection,
- Early Indigenous Participation and Prosperity – An Indigenous economy that benefits from development is essential to reconciliation and future opportunity for all.
- Focus on Unlocking Future Oriented Projects – large-scale low-cost decarbonization within existing industry and market frameworks is essential to Canada's competitiveness
- Bolstering Existing Trade Routes – adding to and optimizing, not replacing, well proven commercial trade routes.
- Use of Existing ROW and Infrastructure - Where possible routes should bolster existing infrastructure by paralleling and optimizing thereby reducing adverse environmental and social impacts.
